#### **Before you apply please read carefully:**

Check our website under the heading *Class Finder* for details of any class you are interested in joining. Click on the class title for information about the class. If you are interested in joining a class, phone the Leader and ask if there is a vacancy.

If an 'F' appears at the end of the class title then, unfortunately, the class is currently full. You can still phone the Leader and ask to be placed on their waiting list or they will provide you with a phone number for a central contact.

If you do not have access to the internet please phone the Poole U3A office during opening hours and our volunteer helpers will be able to provide the information.

With most classes it is possible to attend for **one week** on a trial basis before joining Poole U3A. This is at the discretion of the class leader.

When applying to join, simply complete our Membership Form and send it to the Poole U3A office with the subscription fee and an SAE and you will then receive a membership card.

Alternatively if you use online or telephone banking, you can join Poole U3A online by visiting our website [www.pooleu3a.org.uk](http://www.pooleu3a.org.uk) and click on 'Join Us'. You will find a link to the online membership form, and after submitting the form, you will need to pay your membership fee through online or telephone banking within 2 working days.

**Please note that the membership fee is non-refundable so ensure you have a place on a class before sending in the subscription fee.**

You can attend any number of different classes, vacancies permitting, but no more than two of the same type ie table tennis/ French etc~ ~In addition there are the monthly talks and all the social events (walks, day trips and Sunday lunches) detailed in this leaflet.

## Pub Walks

## Country Walks

Country Walks are held on Thursdays and start at 10 am prompt, returning by about 1 pm. There is an optional pub lunch after each walk. Walks are usually between five and six miles in length and are at a moderate pace. Suitable walking boots are recommended

**Thursday 7 Sept, Affpuddle Heath car park and picnic area** – a 5 mile walk through heathland and wooded areas. Take the A35 from Bere Regis towards Dorchester, then take the first exit onto the B3390 towards Crossways. The car park is at a road junction on the left, ¼ mile south of Affpuddle village

**Thursday 12 Oct : White Mill, Sturminster Marshall** – a 6 mile walk to Shapwick and return on riverside paths, tracks and minor roads. Park in the National Trust car park opposite White Mill, postcode BH21 4BX. Lunch at the Red Lion, Sturminster Marshall.

**Thursday 9 November : Fritham car park, New Forest** – a 5½ mile walk mainly on forest tracks. Drive through Fritham village and park in the Forestry Commission car park on the left beyond the Royal Oak pub, postcode SO43 7HJ.

**Thursday 7 December : Worlds End, Almer** - park in the Worlds End pub car park adjoining the A31 for a 5½ mile walk on a variety of bridleways and minor lanes. The pub postcode is DT11 9EW.

Our Guest Speakers for the Autumn term are:

### **October 6<sup>th</sup>. "Mary Rose, 500 years under the sea to her new museum"**

Dr. Ken Collins and Jenny Mallinson of Southampton University/National Oceanography Centre were both involved with the raising of the Mary Rose, King Henry VIII's Flagship, in 1982. They have since worked closely with the Maritime Trust, and for the 35<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of its raising will bring the story up to date with recent discoveries and a guide to the new museum.
